



Parents and Volunteers Game Day Duties



Each team is required to provide parents or volunteers at homes games to cover the following duties:

Field Set Up: If your team is the first to play on your field you will be required to assist with field set up at 7:00am – minimum 2 people required for each field

Canteen: 1 hour before game regardless of when kick off is. – 2 persons required

BBQ: 1 hour before game regardless of when kick off is - 1 person required

****Note: please be on time for canteen and BBQ as the parents you are relieving want to watch their child play.*

Ground Manager: During your team's game - 1 person required.

Overview of ground manager is required duties:

- Wear a ground manager vest to identify themselves as doing this duty
- ensure spectators remain behind the roped off areas
- ensure coaches, managers, trainers and reserves from both teams remain seated
- Discourage spectators from using bad language and abusing referees

This is a brief overview of ground managers duties, for more details on the ground managers role we can provide a training pack.

Field Pack Up: If your team has the last game on the field all available parents/volunteers are required to assist with field pack up.

It is a responsibility of the team manager to organise their team's parents and volunteers to cover these duties.

Duties	When/Time	People	Details
Field Set Up	7.00 am (approximately 1 hour)	2	Set out ropes, cones, chairs and tables. Set up mini field/s goal posts
Canteen	1 hour prior to game	2	Help serve customers in the canteen
BBQ:	1 hour prior to game	1	Help cook BBQ and serve customers
Ground Manager	During the game	1	To ensure monitor and control crowd behaviour.
Field Pack Up	Follow the last Game on that field	All	Take down ropes and pack up cones, goal posts, chairs and tables
